Transmitters:—1 FONE 10 watts (rated) Hartley Oscillator using Heissing
Modulation. 500 volt Westinghouse motor-generator. Rad **2.6 tca**

2. CW. 20 watts (rated) **98** watts input 500 volts

D.C. in Hartley oscillator. Rad **3.4 tca on 200 metres.**

3. CW. 50-100 watts (rated) **150** watts input **1300** volts

C.R.A.C. in Hartley oscillator. Rad **2.7 on 130m & 6.5 on 220**

Receiver:—1 BGF type of low loss tuner and **1** steps audio amplification.

Antenna:—Six wire flat top 76 ft. x 75 ft. high and 75 ft. long.

Counterpoise:—Nine wire fan 50 ft. long by 50 ft. wide and 25 ft. high.
